- Bunkers with consistent sand for a fair shot. Clean edged bunkers that add to the beauty of the course.
- Continuing improvements to the irrigation system which will result in less day time watering and a more consistent playing surface.
- Improved conditioning of hazards and natural areas for better shot making and ball recovery.

I would like to thank you for your ongoing support. I am very proud of the fact Twin Lakes is improving despite the current economic times. Many of the resources used for these improvements can go noticed by the average golfer.
